[Code signing certificates](#) are used to digitally sign software or applications and protect users from running maliciously altered code. These certificates also validate organizations that distribute software as trusted sources.

When users install programs, they are prompted about trusting the source before proceeding. If the software was distributed by a publisher who utilized a code signing certificate, then their verified entity name will be displayed as the provider instead of an untrusted or unknown source.

DigiCert code signing certificates include the following benefits:

compatibility with Microsoft, Java, Apple, and Adobe applications and Mozilla objects, availability in 1-, 2-, or 3-year term lengths, and full access to DigiCert's award-winning support team.

Customers only need one code signing certificate that can then be used across various applications or operating systems. [DigiCert code signing](#) starts as low as \$178 per year, depending on the term length.

Exporting Code Signing Certificates

One certificate can be used across all applications

Most code signing certificates are installed to your computer through a web browser but each type of application uses the certificate differently.

If you order and install a Microsoft Authenticode certificate, then the certificate will be available in the Internet Explorer store and can be used for other Microsoft programs by running the Microsoft code signing utility to find and reference the certificate.



Code signing certificates can be utilized across different applications or operating systems by exporting it to a .pfx file. [Exporting instructions](#) are available for various platforms on the DigiCert website. Once exported, run the code signing utility specific to the application you want to sign and then reference the .pfx file to sign it.
