# Windows Root Certificate Program

## Microsoft updates technical requirements

Recently, Microsoft updated the Windows Root Certificate Program to include interim technical requirements for Certification Authority (CA) Practices under Section F of the program. These interim requirements will be incorporated into industry-wide baseline requirements that DigiCert has assisted in developing as a member of the CA/Browser Forum.

The new requirements under Section F are as follows:

1. CAs will implement multi-factor authentication.
2. All root certificates must be maintained in an offline state.
3. Resellers and Registration Authorities (RAs) may not issue certificates on behalf of a CA.

DigiCert already meets all of the new technical requirements under Section F and is continually working to improve the quality of the industry and the value of the service DigiCert provides through involvement with such organizations as the CA/Browser Forum.
